#### 6th GRADE UPDATES

**ELA:** This week, we continued our study of pronouns, focusing on subject and object pronouns and correct usage within our writing. We also reviewed character traits and characterization in *The Cay*. Students completed a study guide for Ch. 13-19, and we watched the made for TV movie of the novel. We discussed the differences between made for TV movies and characteristics of the novel, determining that reading that novel was much more fulfilling than a movie that negates important historical context and events. In addition, we began reviewing story plot definitions for our upcoming short story unit, applying the terminology to *The Cay*, a familiar text.

## 7th GRADE UPDATES

**ELA:** Grammar–This week we reviewed sentence types for our quiz. We also completed IXL practice on sentence types. *Dragonwings*–This week, we read through Chapter 2 and continued to work on understanding the historical context of the novel connecting to concepts learned in social studies. In addition, we worked on vocabulary strategies, including context clues and being able to write sentences that include context clues for assigned vocabulary words.
