6th GRADE UPDATES

Language Arts: We dug deeply into the morality and values of the society in *The Giver* with some individual reflections and an informal debate. This weekend, students are to read and take notes on chapters 14-17 of *The Giver*, and to review their notes about the Elements of Fiction for a Fiction Quiz on Friday 10/6.

Social Studies: The students learned the basics of economics, such as opportunity cost, and supply and demand. Next week we will finish with the basics of economics, the four types of economic systems, and some personal economics.

Vocab Quiz - Tuesday 10/4

Science: We missed a few class meetings this week and will continue to do so next week for MAP testing, but between that, we continued to talk about the processes of sea-floor spreading and subduction. Next week we will be reaching the end of the chapter and beginning our study guide for the Chapter 1 test.

Theology: We learned about the stories of Adam and Eve. The students made newscasts about the events in the Garden of Eden to reinforce their learning. Next week we'll look at the fall of man, and how God wants us to be made in his image.

7th GRADE UPDATES

Language Arts: We looked at two short stories by the American author O. Henry, and learned about well-crafted plot twists and surprise endings. Next week, we will continue with these two stories to review what we've learned about fiction thus far for the Fiction Quiz on Friday 10/6. No homework, except to review their Fiction notes.

Social Studies: The students learned how the Roman Republic became the Roman Empire. We discussed the Punic wars, and Julius Caesar. Next week, we will discuss the beginning of the Roman Empire, and Rome's achievements.

Theology: We MAP tested during and learned about the different Gospel writers. Next week, we will continue to take the MAP test and learn about the inspiration for the Gospels.

Science: The class finished reviewing and took their Chapter 1 tests this week. After that, we have begun to learn about the different states of matter and what causes particles to move through these phases. We will continue with this concept next week.

8th GRADE UPDATES

Language Arts: We had a tough grammar lesson about the different functions of nouns; students had to push themselves, and I was very impressed! We also got started on our Short Story creative writing project. We will outline our short stories in-class and as homework on Monday (though students are free to do that over the weekend), and then we'll review for our Fiction Quiz on Friday 10/6.

History: Students learned about the Revolutionary War, how women and African Americans made an impact, and how the tide started turning towards the United States. Next week, we will finish the Revolutionary War, discuss the Treaty of Paris, and students will start an essay.

Science: The students began the week by reviewing for their Chapter 1 test, which was taken on Wednesday. We are then moving into Chapter 2, learning about cells. The students received their cell project description in class this week, and are expected to bring back the signed parent acknowledgement next week, as part of their project grade.

Math 8G1: Students learned about congruent figures. Next week students will learn about translations, reflections and rotations in the coordinate plane.

Math 8G2: Students learned about writing and graphing inequalities as well as solving inequalities using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Next week students will learn about solving multi-step inequalities.
