## 6th GRADE UPDATES

Language Arts: We focused a lot of our time on crafting rough drafts of our descriptive scene writing assignment, which are due next week. It's been a very creative space these last few days. We also wrapped up our lessons about nouns. Students will be finishing up The Giver by next Thursday.

Social Studies: We finished discussing the basics of economics, we discussed the different economic systems, and we talked a tad bit about personal finances. Next week, we will discuss the basics of government, the origins, the different types, and how governments resolve conflict and cooperate.

## 8th GRADE UPDATES

Language Arts: We worked on building our short story rough drafts.
