## 6th GRADE UPDATES

**Language Arts:** We continued our poetry unit this week by reading and writing some haikus, which was a fun way to dive in! Students also began to study verbs while I was out sick, and I heard great things about their behavior with the sub. Next week, we will studying - and writing - a Psalm of thanksgiving before the holiday!

**Social Studies:** We discussed the origins of civilization. Specifically, the "Out of Africa" theory, artifacts of early humans, hunter-gatherers, and the importance of creations such as fire. Next week, we will discuss the development of complex cultures, meaning we will discuss cave paintings and paleolithic cave art. Students will also take their vocab quiz on Monday.

**Science:** We have been continuing with the processes that change the shape of the earth. We talked about mass movement events and then focused on the causes of erosion. Next week, we will be talking about the types of land formations that result from sediment being deposited.

**Social Studies:** We discussed the cultures of the first North American people and how they had to overcome and adapt to the different regions that they lived in. Next week we will finish discussing the cultures of North American people, more specifically, their religious beliefs and how they organized alliances. The students will take their vocab quiz on Monday.

**Theology:** We discussed and analyzed how the different Gospel writers interpreted the Baptism of Jesus. We also discussed the relationship between John the Baptist and Jesus. Next week we will look at the temptation of Jesus in the desert.

**Science:** We began the week by reviewing for our test on the types of chemical bonds on Wednesday. Then we began chapter 4 which is all about chemical reactions. Next week we will introduce balancing equations.

**Math 7G1:** Students learned about solving inequalities using addition and subtraction. Next week students will learn about solving inequalities using multiplication and division as well as solving two-step inequalities.

## 8th GRADE UPDATES

**Language Arts:** We studied the imagery and speakers of our first poems, "Mother to Son" by Langston Hughes and "Speech to the Young" by Gwendolyn Brooks.
