# 6th GRADE UPDATES

**Language Arts:** We worked in pairs to practice writing formal, professional emails. We also prepared for the students' verb quiz next week with study guides, practice questions, and a Kahoot! The study guide and practice problems can be found on Canvas, linked on the agenda for Wednesday.

**Social Studies:** We finished talking about the Persian Empire, and students started their research and the creation of their Persian Emperor projects. These are due next Thursday, and students will present Thursday and Friday. Next week we will discuss the Phoenicians. They will also get a study guide for a test covering the Early Empires.

**Science:** We have been learning about the layers of the atmosphere this week, and how they are separated based on changes in temperature. Then we have been learning about how energy travels to us from the sun and how that energy moves through our atmosphere. Next week, that will lead into learning about wind.

**Theology:** We talked about the 10 plagues and the impact they had on Egypt. We also looked more at the life of Moses. Next week, we will continue to look at the life of Moses and the Exodus. We will also have a virtue quiz on Circumspection.

# 8th GRADE UPDATES

**Language Arts:** We continued to find sources for the students' final project research papers. We also continued our literature circle discussions – we're getting into the rising actions of each novel now! Students also started preparing for next week's verb quiz with a study guide and practice problems, which will be available on Canvas all week.

**History:** We discussed John Adams's Presidency, along with the XYZ Affair, and how this led to the division of the Federalist Party. Then, we will discuss the Election of 1800s and students will start their Election of 1800s debate project.

**Science:** We have continued to learn about plants, focusing this week on the ways that different types of plants reproduce. Next week, we will continue with the parts of a flower, how plants respond to their surroundings, and how we use plants in our lives.

**Math 8G1:** Students learned about linear functions and comparing linear and nonlinear functions. Next week, they will learn about analyzing and sketching functions and will start to review for the Chapter 6 assessments.
