## **6th Grade Updates**

**ELA:** We we talked about the society of *The Giver*, and the ways they relate to emotions and celebrations. We also introduced our first writing assignment of the year, the Character Analysis Essay. We will begin working on this next week.

**Social Studies:** We finished our 5 Themes of Geography projects, had a discussion about 9/11, and talked about globes, maps, and map distortions. Next week we will start by continuing our discussion of map distortions, and then change gears to start discussing the basics of economics. We also will discuss the constitution due to it being CONSTITUTION DAY on Tuesday!! Students will also have their first vocab quiz on Friday 9/20. They will receive their study guide on Monday, and we will go over the study guide on Thursday.

**Science:** We began to learn about plate tectonics this week by introducing Alfred Wegener and his theory of continental drift. Next week, we will learn about the geological processes that cause that the movements on the Earth's surface.

**Theology:** We discussed the different genres of the Old Testament. The students also did a scavenger hunt helping them get more familiar with the Bible. They also took their virtue quiz on circumspection. Next week we will continue to delve more into how scripture is God's saving world, as we look at the Old and New Testament.

**Math 6G1:** The students took the first quiz of Chapter 1 and they learned about prime factorization. Next week they will learn about the greatest common factor and least common multiple.

**Math 6G2:** Students took the first quiz of Chapter 1. They also learned about prime factorization, greatest common factor, and least common multiple. Next week we will wrap up Chapter 1 with the second quiz, a vocabulary quiz, a review of the chapter and the Chapter 1 Test.

## 7th Grade Updates

**ELA:** We talked about stereotypes in *The Outsiders*, and students practiced using textual evidence to write a newspaper article about the inciting incident of our story. We also practiced writing Hamburger Paragraphs in preparation for our first quarter presentation project, which we will introduce next week.

**Social Studies:** We discussed society in the ancient Roman Republic; including men's and women's roles, the rich and the poor, slavery, and religion. Students started their comparison essay between the United States society today and ancient Rome's society, which will be due Wednesday, 9/18. Next week we will also discuss the Punic Wars. Students will read a section, create a poster, and teach their section of the Punic War to the rest of the class. We also will discuss the constitution due to it being CONSTITUTION DAY on Tuesday! Friday, students will be given their first study guide for their first vocab quiz, which will be on Tuesday, 9/24.

**Theology:** We talked about Jesus as our savior, the Trinity and the image of Mary in the Church. The students also took their virtue quiz on Circumspection. Next week we talk about Jesus as a friend, and examine Jesus as the Son of Man.

**Science:** We have continued to focus on matter this week by learning about the Periodic Table. We discussed how to measure volume, mass, and density, then practiced by calculating the densities of different types of candy. Next week, we will focus on the ways that matter can change, both physically and chemically.

## 8th Grade Updates

**ELA:** We wrapped up our discussion of our first short story, "Checkouts," by analyzing the conflict and theme of the story. We also started brainstorming and outlining for our Short Story writing assignment. Next week, we will discuss our next story, "The Chaser."

**History:** We finished up our discussion on the Declaration of Independence and started discussing the Revolutionary war. Next week we will continue discussing the Revolutionary War, specifically foreign aid, and Valley Forge. Students will learn about the harsh winter at Valley Forge.
