
Middle School Exams: Tuesday – Thursday, Dec. 17-19

6th Grade Updates

ELA: We learned about odes and worked in groups to write an ode to our favorite Christmas decoration! We also each wrote two lines to contribute to a class ballad about how our 2024 was. During our final exam time next week, students will assemble all our poems from this quarter into a poetry portfolio, which will serve as their final exam.

Social Studies: We began our project of creating our own civilizations. The students used their knowledge of the eight parts of civilizations and their creativity to complete a rough draft of their civilizations. Then, the students began to study for their exams. Their exams are next week.

Science: We finished up learning about the Geologic Time Scale this week by focusing on the eras and periods in Earth's history. Then we spent some time talking about different methods of studying and the techniques that best help to retain information. We then moved into reviewing for next week's exam.

7th Grade Updates

ELA: We wrapped up our last Hamburger Paragraph for our final Poetry Pairing Project. Students will spend our ELA exam time finishing up creating slides and notes for their presentation and need to submit a recorded screencast of their presentation by midnight on Wednesday, the day of our exam.

Social Studies: Students learned about the beginning of the Renaissance and European exploration, particularly the importance of the printing press and Columbus' voyages. Then, the students began to study for their exams. Their exams are next week.

Theology: The students finished up learning about the gospel of John and then worked on their exam study guide. Exams next week.

Science: We began the week by going over the methods of controlling chemical reactions, such as increasing concentration or adding a catalyst. We then reviewed study skills before moving into exam prep.
