


Blackbaud Financial Aid!

Cooped up with the kids in this cold, cold weather? Consider a drop in day at childcare for your 3 or 4 year old. Students **currently enrolled** in P3 or P4 are eligible to drop in for childcare with a minimum of a 24-hour notice. This program runs from 11am-3:20pm, Monday-Friday.
