6th Grade Updates

ELA: We finished up the rough drafts of our Opinion Essays this week and prepared for our upcoming second Parts of Speech test. Next week, students will revise their essays and take a grammar test–and have a fun Read-In day on Wednesday!

Social Studies: Students finished their Pharaohs of Egypt Brochure poject. Then, we reviewed what we learned in this section of the Unit. We also discussed the Pyramids. Next week, we will continue our Egypt unit. The students will make Papyrus paper and they will learn how to write their names in Hieroglyphics, learning the importance of both in ancient Egypt. Students will also learn about the importance of Math and Science to the Egyptians. Then, we will discuss the relationship between ancient Kush and Egypt.

Science: We have continued to learn about weather this week. We have been focusing on the use of Canva to make video presentations about severe storm types. Next week, we will learn about how forecasts are made and about reading weather maps before we begin reviewing for the Chapter 9 test.

History: We finished our unit over the War of 1812. The students complete a debate, arguing whether or not the War of 1812 was a mistake. Then, we started our unit on James Monroe's presidency. We will continue our unit next week, discussing important Supreme Court cases and the expansion of the United States, finishing with the Monroe Doctrine.

Science: We have continued to learn about the human body this week. We focused on how all of the body systems must work together to maintain homeostasis. We then learned about the skeletal system. Next week, we will look at the muscular and integumentary systems.

Math 8G1: Students learned about exponents, the product of powers property, the quotient of powers property, as well as zero and negative exponents. Next week, they will learn about rational numbers and exponents as well as estimating quantities. Next week, they will review zero and negative exponents and learn about rational numbers.
