April safety and security!

Here are some items to highlight the safety and security initiatives being explored and implemented in the past month:

- Forming a new partnership through Trinity Health for emergency first aid training for staff.
- Leveraging current technology to implement an additional, campus wide, mass notification system.
- Completing the security camera install and set-up for the new preschool building.
- Implementing a new first aid supply audit and replenishment system.
- Coordinating with GRPD to facilitate access to the building during an emergency.
- Updating emergency policies and procedures to comply with new "standard language" required by 2026 state law.

Lunch Account Balances!

We have many families that have a negative balance in their students' lunch accounts. We need all families to check and submit funds to cover what they owe. Please add enough funds to cover your balance and for hot lunches for the rest of the year. Check out these IC Instructions for adding funds to lunch accounts. As a school, we have a negative balance of nearly \$3,000. We need to take care of this ASAP.

Uniform reminder!

As we finish out the year, please be mindful of uniform holiday dress code. On a uniform holiday, students need to wear shorts/skirts that are an appropriate length. If students come to school out of uniform code, they will call home for a change of clothes.

Smart watches!

We are starting to see more smart watches in the building. Any wearable devices with screens that can connect to cellular or wireless networks are not allowed in school.

New kindergarten requirement!

Students entering kindergarten or the first year of school are required [Public Act 316 of 2023] to have dental assessments within six months of the start of school. If your child has had their dental check up this year and it was on or after February 21, 2025, please go back to your dentist and ask them to <u>complete this form</u>. If you have your dental visit coming up before school begins, please take the form with you. The form must be submitted to the Saint Thomas office on or before August 21. 
