

Faith survey results!

Thank you to all who completed our STA Faith Formation survey. Here are some results: 95.8% of parents see themselves as partners in their child's faith development, and 70.8% notice strong faith formation at our school. 54.2% reported attending School Mass and 41.7% of parents read the Breaking Bread questions in the Buzz. 16.7% of parents participate in Tuesday Adoration and Rosary. Parents shared that their children are thriving in faith through daily prayer, weekly Mass, chapel talks, and the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program. Many see their children leading prayers at home, growing in virtue, and living their Catholic faith with joy. Thank you for your continued support in strengthening our students' faith life!
