6th Grade

Language Arts: We learned about sonnets this week. Sonnets are a pretty tough form of poetry, so I was really impressed with the effort everybody put in to learn about and create sonnets. We also studied for our Verb Quiz next week.

Verb Quiz - Monday, November 24

Social Studies: Students took their Early Humans Test. Then, we started discussing the second part of our Origins of Civilizations Unit. We discussed the Neolithic Age, how it transformed into the Bronze Age, and how settlements began to form. Next week, we will discuss the 8 features of civilizations and the history of Thanksgiving.

Science: We spent most of the week focusing on how erosion and deposition shape the Earth's surface by moving sediment and creating new land features as the sediment builds up in new locations. We ended the week by starting to review for next week's test.

Chapter 3 & 4 Test- Tuesday, November 25

Theology: We did a couple of STEAM activities revolving around Noah's Arc and the Tower of Babel. The students were given specific instructions to follow to build the arc, and had to build the Tower while barely communicating. Next week, we start talking about Moses.

Math 6G1: Students took a test and learned about ratios and how to use a tape diagram to solve ratio problems. Next week, they will learn about ratio tables and use them to solve ratio problems. There will be NO IXL next week.

7th Grade

Language Arts: We studied the Emily Dickinson poem "Hope is the Thing with Feathers" and watched the Pixar short "Piper" to compare and contrast the different lessons we learn about hope and perseverance in both. We also reviewed for our Verb Quiz and continued work on our Poetry Pairing Final Project.

Social Studies: We finished discussing the Incas. Then, we began discussing early Native Americans in North America. The students received their Early Americas Study Guide. Their test will be on Wednesday, December 3. Next week, we will continue to discuss early Native American tribes, specifically with ties to Thanksgiving.

Science: We are focusing on chemical reactions in Chapter 4. This will include learning to balance equations to follow the law of conservation of mass. We will also look at how reactions can be controlled with catalysts and inhibitors.
