MIDDLE SCHOOL Exams

Middle school exams are approaching – Dec. 16-18. Please check the Middle School Exam Schedule to find out which subjects your student has on each day. The first exam is 8:25-9:55am; the second is 10-11:30am. These are half days for middle schoolers ONLY; dismissal is at 11:30am.

6th Grade

Language Arts: Students worked on editing and assembling our Poetry Portfolios, which will serve as their ELA Midterm Exam. During their exam time next week, we'll design covers for our portfolios and share our work. We also had our last grammar lesson of the unit; after break, we'll review all of our verb content and then have a test at the end of second quarter.

Social Studies: We finished presenting our civilization projects. Then we began exam prep. Students will have their Social Studies exam on Thursday.

Social Studies Exam - Thursday, December 18

Science: We finished up Chapter 5 this week by looking more closely at the major events from each of the eras and periods of Earth's history. Then we began to review for the exam next week. The exam will cover plate tectonics, earthquakes, weathering, erosion and deposition, and the Geologic time scale.

Theology: The students this week finished learning about the Jewish Patriarchs and reviewed for next week's exams.
